

Supervision of Young People Statement

The home (referring) school or agency is expected to organise travel arrangements for the young people, to and from RISE Learning Zone. The young people remain the responsibility of the home school during these times. The home school may decide to allow young people to leave home and travel directly to us on public transport, and vice versa on their return journey, if they are not required in school premises.

Once the young people have accessed RISE's site, they become the responsibility of RISE.

Break times, both inside and outside of the site are supervised by a worker.

When leaving the premises, the young people will be escorted to the exit by a worker, to ensure they leave the building safely.

Students are not permitted to leave the Rise site during breaks and lunchtime.

For trips and visits arranged by RISE, where travel has to be provided, the young people and their parents will be given written notice, and permission sought from parents and home schools for the excursion. Where possible, travel arrangements will be made using public transport. When this is not possible other transport arrangements will be made, i.e.: car, minibus. The young people will be covered by appropriate insurance.
